



Inclusion Ideas: Winter Walk Day

Some students really want to participate in Winter Walk Day but for whatever reason they are unable to walk to school. Here are some ideas **from MPS Schools** that allow more students to participate. Students could also write about a winter walking experience to get the I WALKED sticker, etc.

In the MORNING at arrival:

Designate a spot away from school where families that drive can meet and walk together to school.

Design and mark a walk around the school grounds, assign volunteers where needed, and invite students who ride the school bus or who are dropped off by car to walk the loop once or more at arrival to school.



At RECESS or during the school day:

Designate a walking path on the playground and invite all students to walk during recess.

Designate a winter walk path and classrooms can take turns throughout the day making the walk.
